





3. As smoke is driven away, so drive them away; †
like wax that melts before *the fire*, *
so the wicked shall perish at the *presence of God*.

they shall exult with *glad rejoicing*.

Extol the One who rides on *the clouds*. *
The LORD is his name; exult *at his presence*.


Psalm 30 (29): [3], 4, 5-6, 7-8, 9-10

Can dust give you thanks, or proclaim *your* faithfulness?”




