





He has remembered his merciful **love** *
and his truth for the *house of Israel*.

break forth into joyous **song**, *
and sing *out your praise*.
4. Sing psalms to the **LORD** with the **harp**, *

and your faithfulness to the great *assembly*.




Psalm 89 (88): 4-5, 27-28, 29-30

and his throne as lasting as the days *of heaven*.



Who shall stand in his *holy place*?

1. Have mercy on me, *O God*, *

 blot out *my transgressions*.
 Wash me completely from my *iniquity*, *
 and cleanse me *from my sin*.
2. My transgressions, truly *I know* them; *
 my sin is *always before* me.
 Against you, you alone, have *I sinned*; *
 what is evil in your sight *I have done*.
3. What is evil in your sight I have done. †
 So you are just in *your sentence*, *
 without reproach *in your judgment*.
 O see, in guilt I *was born*, *
 a sinner when my mother *conceived* me.

 Turn away your face from *my sins*, *
 and blot out *all my guilt*.


Re-ate a clean heart in me, O Lord.
