

who seek the face of the God *of Jacob*.

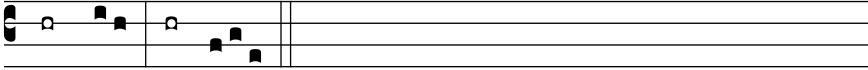


2. Let the heavens rejoice and earth be glad; *



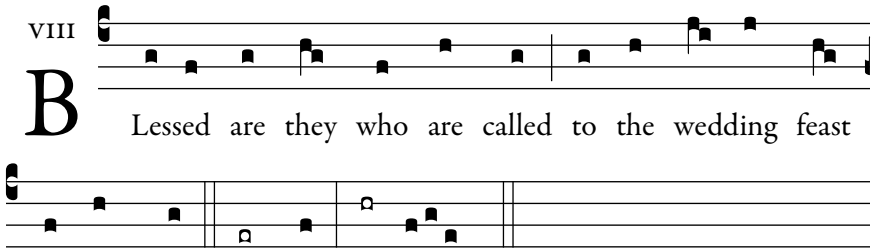


Psalm 57 (56): 3, 4, 8, 9, 10-11, 12


