he sets me high upon a rock.


7. Glory be to the Father, and to *the* Son, *



 “*Seek his* face.”







 so far from us does he remove *our transgressions*.


3. The LORD has fixed his throne in **heaven**, *





with trum-pet blast, al- le- lu- ia.


Psalm 47 (46): 2-3, 4-5, 6-7, 8-9, 10
