





“In you, all find *their home*.”







Psalm 67 (66): 2-3, 5, 6 and 8




Psalm 89 (88): 2-3, 21-22, 25 and 27

 my God, the rock of *my salvation*.'





## Psalm 2: 6-7, 8-9, 10-11ab

1. "It is I who have appointed *my king* \*  
on Sion, my *holy mountain*."  
I will announce the decree of the LORD: †  
The LORD said to me, "You are *my Son*. \*  
It is I who have begotten *you this day*."
2. Ask of me and I will give you †  
the nations as your *inheritance*, \*  
and the ends of the earth as *your possession*.  
With a rod of iron you *will rule* them; \*  
like a potter's jar *you will shatter* them."
3. So now, O kings, *understand*; \*  
take warning, rulers *of the earth*.  
Serve the LORD *with fear*; \*  
exult with trembling, pay *him your homage*.

 Shout to the LORD, all the earth; †  
 break forth into *joyous song*, \*  
 and sing *out your praise*.
