
## Luke 1: 46-55



Psalm 147 (146): 1, 2-4, 5-7, 8-9, 10-11, 12-14

1. How good to sing psalms to *our God*; \*  
how pleasant to chant *fitting praise*!
2. The LORD builds up *Jerusalem* \*  
and brings back *Israel's exiles*;  
he heals the *brokenhearted*; \*  
he binds up all *their wounds*.  
He counts out the number of *the stars*; \*
