
Psalm 72 (71): 1-2, 3-4, 7-8



Psalm 72 (71): 1-2, 10, 12-13

They shall pray for him *without ceasing*, *
and bless him *all the day*.

Every tribe shall *be blest* in him, *
all nations shall *call him blessed*.

Psalm 149 (148): 1b-2, 3-4, 5-6a and 9b

2. Let them praise his name *with dancing*, *
and make music with *timbrel and harp*.
