


**Y**OU will draw wa- ter joy- ful- ly from the springs



1. [I sought for one who would console me, \*  
and *I found none.*]
  
2. Save me, O God, for the waters \*

I have sunk into the mud of the **deep**, \*  
where there *is no foothold.*  
I have entered the waters of the **deep**, \*

nor go back on the promise of *my lips*.


