




B Les-sed are all who take ref-uge in the Lord.

Psalm 2: 1-3, 4-7a, 7b-9

1. Why do the nations **conspire**, *
and the peoples *plot in vain*?
They arise, the kings of the **earth**; *
princes plot against the LORD and *his Anointed*.
“Let us burst asunder their **fetters**. *
Let us cast off from *us their chains*.”
2. He who sits in the heavens **laughs**; *
the LORD *derides and mocks* them.
Then he will speak in his **anger**, *
his rage will strike *them with terror*.
“It is I who have appointed my king †
on Sion, my holy **mountain**.” *
I will announce the decree *of the LORD*:

With a rod of iron you will **rule** them; *


like a potter’s jar *you will shatter* them.”





Psalm 93 (92): 1ab, 1cd-2, 5



Psalm 34 (33): 2-3, 4-5, 6-7




but from them all the LORD will *rescue him*.


