




### RESPONSORIAL PSALM

*Ps 103 (102): 10a*

**L** Ord, do not deal with us ac-cording to our sins.



Psalm 79 (78): 8, 9, 11 and 13

1. Do not remember *against* us \*  
the guilt of *former* times.  
Let your compassion hasten *to meet* us;\*  
for we have been brought very *low*.
2. Help us, O God *our* savior, \*  
for the sake of the glory of *your* name.  
Free us and forgive us *our* sins, \*  
because of *your* name.
3. Let the groans of the prisoners come *before* you, \*  
your strong arm relieve those condemned *to die*.  
Then we, your people, the flock of your pasture, †  
will give you thanks forever *and ever*. \*  
From age to age we will recount *your* praise.

RESPONSORIAL PSALM

*Ps 50 (49): 23b*

Psalm 50 (49): 8-9, 16bc-17, 21 and 23

1. "I do not rebuke you for *your* sacrifices; \*  
 your offerings are always *before* me.  
 I do not take more bullocks from *your* farms, \*  
 nor goats from among *your* herds."
  
2. "How can you recite my *commandments*, \*  
 and take my covenant on *your* lips,  
 you who despise *correction*, \*  
 and cast my words *behind* you?"
  
3. "You do this, and should I keep silence? †  
 Do you think that I am *like you*? \*  
 I accuse you, lay the charge *before* you.  
 A sacrifice of praise gives me honor, †  
 and to one whose way *is* blameless, \*  
 I will show the salvation *of* God."

**Psalm 1:** 1-2, 3, 4 and 6

1. Blessed indeed is *the man* \*  
 who follows not the counsel *of the wicked*,  
 nor stands in the path *with sinners*, \*  
 nor abides in the company *of scorners*,  
 but whose delight is the law *of the LORD*, \*  
 and who ponders his law *day and night*.
  
2. He is like a tree that is planted †  
 beside the *flowing waters*, \*  
 that yields its fruit *in due season*,  
 and whose leaves shall *never fade*; \*  
 and all that he *does shall prosper*.
  
3. Not so are the wicked, not so! †  
 For they, like *winnowed chaff*, \*  
 shall be driven away *by the wind*.  
 for the LORD knows the way *of the just*, \*  
 but the way of the wicked *will perish*.


HE Lord is kind and mer-ci-ful.

**Psalm 103 (102):** 1-2, 3-4, 9-10, 11-12


1. Bless the LORD, O *my soul*, \*
