Psalm 68 (67): 2-3ab, 4-5ac, 6-7ab

1. Let God arise; let his *foes be scattered*. \*  
Let those who hate him flee from *his presence*.  
As smoke is driven away, so drive them away; †  
like wax that melts *before the fire*, \*
2. But the just shall rejoice at the *presence of God*; \*  
they shall exult with glad *rejoicing*.  
O sing to God; make music to his name. \*  
The LORD is his name; exult at *his presence*.
3. Father of orphans, defender of *widows*: \*  
such is God in his *holy place*.  
God gives the desolate a home to dwell in; \*  
he leads the prisoners forth into *prosperity*,

He bears our burdens; God is *our savior*.

Sing to God, O kingdoms of the earth.


Psalm 68 (67): 29-30, 33-35a, 35b-36abc

 you yourself who secure *my lot*.
2. I will bless the LORD who *gives me counsel*, \*  
 who even at night directs *my heart*.  
 I keep the LORD *before me* always; \*  
 with him at my right hand, I shall not *be moved*.
3. And so, my heart rejoices, my *soul is glad*; \*  
 even my flesh shall rest *in hope*.  
 For you will not abandon my *soul to hell*, \*  
 nor let your holy one see *corruption*.
4. You will show me the path of life, †  
 the fullness of joy *in your presence*, \*  
 at your right hand, bliss *forever*.

so strong his mercy for *those who fear* him.

mighty in power, fulfilling *his word*.


RESPONSORIAL PSALM

the upright shall *behold his face*.


