



## SIXTH WEEK OF EASTER

Psalm 149 (148): 1b-2, 3-4, 5-6a and 9b

1. Sing a new song to *the LORD*, \*  
his praise in the assembly *of the faithful*.  
Let Israel rejoice in *its Maker*; \*  
let Zion's children exult *in their king*.
2. Let them praise his name *with dancing*, \*  
and make music with timbrel *and harp*.  
For the LORD takes delight in *his people*; \*  
he crowns the poor *with salvation*.
3. Let the faithful exult *in glory*, \*  
and rejoice as they *take their rest*.  
Let the praise of God be in *their mouths* \*  
This is an honor for all his faithful. *Alleluia*.


Y Our right hand saves me, O Lord.

I give thanks *to your name*.
2. for your merciful love and *your faithfulness*. \*  
You have exalted your name *over all*.  
On the day I called, you *answered me*; \*  
you increased the strength *of my soul*.
3. With your right hand *you save me*; \*  
the LORD will accomplish *this for me*.  
O LORD, your merciful love is *eternal*; \*  
discard not the work *of your hands*.

princes and all judges of *the earth*,  
young men and maidens *as well*, \*

HE Lord has revealed to the nations his saving power.


Psalm 98 (97): 1, 2-3ab, 3cd-4

has shown his deliverance to *the nations*.  
He has remembered his *merciful love* \*  
and his truth for the house *of Israel*.
3. All the ends of the *earth have seen* \*  
the salvation of *our God*.  
Shout to the LORD, all the earth; †  
break forth into *joyous song*, \*  
and sing out *your praise*.

and nations under *our feet*.  
Our heritage he *chose for us*, \*

Sing praise to our king; *sing praise!*

*Ps 47 (46): 8a*



2. God is king of *all the earth*. \*  
Sing praise with all *your skill*.  
God reigns *over the nations*. \*  
God sits upon his *holy throne*.
3. The princes of the peoples *are assembled* \*  
with the people of the God of Abraham.  
The rulers of the earth *belong to God*, \*  
who is greatly *exalted*.

*Monday*

**John 15 (14): 26b, 27a**

✠. The Spirit of truth will testify to me, says *the Lord*, \*  
and you also *will* testify.

*Tuesday*

**See John 16 (15): 7, 13**

✠. I will send to you the Spirit of truth, says *the Lord*; \*  
he will guide you to *all* truth.

*Wednesday*

**John 14 (13): 16**

✠. I will ask the Father †  
and he will give you *another Advocate* \*  
to be with *you always*.

*Thursday*

**See John 14 (13): 18**

✠. I will not leave your orphans, says *the Lord*; \*  
I will come back to you, and your hearts will *rejoice*.

*Friday*

**See Luke 24 (23): 46, 26**

✠. Christ had to suffer and to rise from *the dead*, \*  
and so enter into *his glory*.

*Saturday*

**John 16 (15): 28**

✠. I came from the Father and have come into *the world*; \*  
now I am leaving the world and going back to *the Father*.
