
1. The heavens declare the glory of **God**, *

Psalm 25: 1-3, 4-5, 6, 7, 8-9, 10-11, 12-14

1. To you, O LORD, I lift *up my soul*. *
In you, O my God, *I have trusted*;
let me not be *put to shame*; *
let not my enemies exult *over me*.
Let none who hope in you be *put to shame*; *
but shamed are those who wantonly *break faith*.

2. O LORD, make me *know your ways*. *
