Psalm 96 (95): 1-3, 4-6, 7-8a, 8bc-9, 11-12a, 12b-13

1. O sing a new song *to the LORD*; \*  
sing to the LORD, *all the earth*.  
O sing to the LORD; *bless his name*. \*  
Proclaim his salvation *day by day*.  
Tell among the *nations his glory*, \*  
and his wonders among *all the peoples*.
2. For the LORD is great and highly *to be praised*, \*
