ci-ful love, for they are from of old.


Psalm 25 (24): [Cf. 2bc and 22], 1-2a, 3, 4, 5

I have loved.


Psalm 119 (118): 1-2, 3-4, 5-6, 7-8

and to the *Holy Spirit*.


