1. Do not fret because of the **wicked**; *
do not envy those *who do* evil,
Trust in the LORD and do **good**; *
then you will dwell in the land and *safely* pasture.
2. The LORD takes note of the days of the **blameless**; *
their heritage will *last forever*.
They shall not be put to shame in evil **days**; *
in time of famine they shall *have their* **fill**.
